This course will examine decisions made at the Paris Climate Agreement Conference of the Parties (COP) in Dubai in late 2023 and the context in which they were made. The world's governments hammered out positions on pressing questions including reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and provision of climate financing to developing countries. The COP's organizing theme was a "Global Stocktake," a comprehensive UN-organized assessment of the level of collective progress that has been made toward meeting the Paris Agreement's goals, and which declared that a "course correction" is urgently needed.
