

PLATO COVID-10 Protocol (Revised Feb. 21, 2022)

Full Statement

The PLATO Covid Advisory Workgroup and the Executive Committee have reviewed our Covid health protocols.

PLATO Courses

- The majority of Spring 2022 courses are online.
- The Curriculum Committee will reach out to our host locations for Spring courses to find out the health protocols for each location. Those protocols will determine what is required at each facility.
- Notices should include a statement that reads: **“Persons wishing to wear a mask at this course are encouraged to do so.”**
- We will tailor our message about masking and other health protocols to be in sync with our host locations.

SEC March Events

- **Milwaukee Rep theater trip – March 16**
 - The health protocols that PLATO and the venue had in place at the time of purchase of theater tickets should remain in place. Some PLATO members may have been influenced by those health protocols when deciding to buy the tickets.
 - Masks will continue to be required on the bus and in the theater for this March 16 event.
 - Proof of vaccination or recent Covid test will continue to be required by the theater for this March 16 event.
- **Social Breakfast Gathering – March 11**
 - Masks will not be required for those attending this breakfast, but anyone feeling more comfortable with a mask is welcome to wear one. Notices should include a statement that reads: **“Persons wishing to wear a mask at this event are encouraged to do so.”**
- **SEC Events after March**
 - **Theater trips and bus rides** will need to follow the health protocols of the venues and the national CDC order regarding public transportation. Once ticket sales have begun for an event that is advertised as requiring vaccinations or recent tests, those protocols shall remain in effect for that trip, regardless of any changes made by the venue after the tickets have gone on sale.
 - **Social breakfast gatherings** will not need to require masking or vaccine or test proof starting with April breakfasts.
 - Notices should include a statement that reads: **“Persons wishing to wear a mask at this event are encouraged to do so.”**

We will continue to monitor the situation as it relates to Covid protocols.
